Introduction</b></p> <p>Thank you for choosing the MightyMic W Bluetooth microphone. In order to use the MightyMic W as a wireless Microphone you will need to use either the MoviePro App for video recording or other voice recording Apps for audio recording. Please visit our website for the latest info on Apps and features. The MightyMic W will also work as a Bluetooth Headset or as a playback device. <p><b>MightyMic W User Manual</b></p> <p><b>4.2 Pairing to an iPhone or iPad device</b></p> <p>To use your Bluetooth Microphone, you must first pair it with a device. Once your Bluetooth Microphone is paired to a specific device, they will remain paired and automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range.</p> <p><b>Pairing instructions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Turn on your iPhone and ensure the Bluetooth function is activated</li> <li>Using the button on the bottom of the microphone set it to the pairing mode</li> <li>In the Settings App on the iPhone select the Bluetooth option. Look for a Bluetooth device listed as "Ampridge"</li> <li>Select the device listed as "Ampridge" to pair it to the microphone. The display should change from "Not Paired" to "Connected"</li> <li>You can use the MightyMic W to play music as well as to control the music player functions such as volume up, next song, etc.</li> </ul> <p><b>4.3 Charging your Bluetooth Microphone</b></p> <p>This Microphone uses a USB to 3.5mm 4pin charging cable. Use a USB charger (not included) to charge your device. Make sure that your device is full charged for atleast 6 hours before initial use. Insert one terminal of your charger cable to a USB charger or USB port of a PC and connect the other terminal to the 3.5mm audio jack. While charging, the red LED on the bottom will remain on. When charging is completed, the LED will turn blue.</p> 	<p><b>MightyMic W User Manual</b></p> <p><b>4.4 Using the MightyMic W Microphone</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make sure the MightyMic W is already paired to your phone or other IOS device. See Section 4.2 for instructions.</li> <li>Make sure your phone is set to airplane mode otherwise you may have recordings interrupted by unwanted calls.</li> </ul> <p><b>Using the MightyMic W with MoviePro for video recording</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If the Bluetooth microphone is connected before the app starts, on starting you will see the text "Bluetooth Microphone".</li> <li>If the Bluetooth microphone is connected after the app starts, the microphone is changed to a Bluetooth microphone and the text "Bluetooth Microphone" appears.</li> <li>If the Bluetooth Microphone is disconnected while the app is active, the app switches to the built-in microphone and the text "Built-in Microphone" appears.</li> <li>To confirm the microphone is connected a test recording or go into the Settings section. Upon leaving the Settings section the Bluetooth microphone will become active again and the "Bluetooth Microphone" message will appear again.</li> <li>Playback of the sound will occur through the headphone jack on the MightyMic W while connected via Bluetooth.</li> <li>Many updates are planned for Bluetooth options to further enhance the features. Please check the website for updates regarding this or other features.</li> </ol> <p><b>Using the MightyMic W for audio recording</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The MightyMic W will support audio App's designed to work with external Bluetooth devices.</li> <li>An audio App is needed such as Voice Recorder HD to do Bluetooth audio recording. FAQ</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Why isn't there a signal even when the Microphone is powered on? Ans: Ensure the battery is fully charged up to 6 hours before using for the first time. The LED will light when it starts charging.</li> <li>There is no sound during playback. Ans: The default playback is through the jack on the MightyMic. Check the connection between your device and your phone, if the connection is not established, please reconnect again. Make sure the Microphone is paired and connected with your target phone or other device.</li> <li>Can the microphone connect with a second phone? Ans: Yes, it can, please set the Microphone to multipoint mode. Connect the Microphone to phone A, then once again enter into the pairing mode (phone A, will disconnect), and connect the Microphone to phone B. Then use the phone A paired device list to reconnect to the Microphone.</li> </ol> <p><b>Warning:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You must select a qualified charger from a reliable manufacturer</li> <li>Do not use the USB charger cable on any other device because of possible damage</li> <li>Unit contains Li-Ion polymer batteries.
